CUK do not require a Test of Proficiency in Korean(TOPIK). 400 hours of previous Korean language study experience or attaining 2nd grade on TOPIK is recommended for students who take classes taught in Korean.

Since visa issuance process may take a considerable time, you are requested to submit the required documents as soon as you get the certificate of admission from CUK.</p> Application Process <p>After receiving the certificate of admission from CUK, students must visit the nearest Korean Embassy or Consulate with the required documents and apply for the relevant visa.</p>
